




The Attendant will also be required to scan in their fingerprint. they must press the Start Capture button and place their fingerprint on the scanner.

CLEAR Admin users will be able to add new Attendant records by clicking ADD NEW ATTENDANT button. The Add New Attendant page will be opened and a new Attendant record will be created.

3.0) MENU
The contextual Menu allows Admin Users to access several system level actions. These actions include Log Out, Restart, Shutdown, User Management and Diagnostic Mode.

4.0) ATTENDANT RECORD
These features will help feature CLEAR's Twitter feed, News and Featured Events.

4.1) MODIFY USER NAME
The Current User Name field displays the currently active user name. If the contents of this field are changed and the Modify User Name is pressed, the system will check to see if the new user name is available. If it is, the user name will be changed. If not, the user will be alerted to submit a different user name. If the user cancels this update, the existing user name will remain in use.

4.2) MODIFY PASSWORD
The Current Password is displayed within the Current Password field. The password may be updated by changing the values within the Current Password AND Confirm Password fields to the same alphanumeric password.

4.3) ASSIGN BIOMETRICS
This drop down will allow the Admin to select a specific biometric for the specified user. The specified Biometric will not be set until the Assign Biometrics button is pressed.

4.4) LOCK/UNLOCK
Admins can Lock or Unlock a specified user using this button.

5.0) HELP, GO BACK AND EXIT MANAGEMENT
The page header will alert the user of their contextual placement.






