SportingNews has asked Omnigon Communications to conduct a competitive analysis of the mobile marketplace. Over the last two weeks, we have looked at several different mobile websites and compiled several lists of applications for the many handsets and operating systems out on the marketplace.

We are proud to present the following report of our findings, research and recommendations. We have developed this report to enable the initials production of SportingNews Mobile.

BACKGROUND

Wikipedia defines Sporting News services as the following:

"Sporting News (previously The Sporting News, and known colloquially as TSN) is an American-based sports magazine. It was established in 1886, and it became the dominant American publication covering baseball — so much so that it acquired the nickname "The Bible of Baseball". Along with its affiliated radio network, Sporting News Radio, it is currently owned by Charlotte, North Carolina-based American City Business Journals, a subsidiary of Advance Publications.

SN currently covers seven main sports — Major League Baseball (MLB), the National Basketball Association (NBA), the National Football League (NFL), the National Hockey League (NHL), NASCAR, and NCAA men's basketball and football — with occasional coverage of other sports. Following 122 years of existence as a weekly publication, the magazine switched to a bi-weekly publishing schedule in 2008. Earlier that year, it launched a daily online newspaper, Sporting News Today."

HIGH LEVEL FUNCTIONALITY SPECIFICATIONS

We recommend that the following four areas of functionality are given significant attention on mobile devices.

FOUR AREAS OF FUNCTIONALITY

- 1. Big Topics / Super Stories
- 2. Developing Stories
- 3. Personalization
- 4. Data Visualization & Advanced Analysis

BIG TOPICS / SUPER STORIES

On the website, Big Topics are displayed with specific prominence to viewers, with the ability to view all. Mobile users should see the same attention to these Big Topics, which are links to important Super Stories. These stories should push a social lens to engage users via multiple entry points, e.g. Facebook, Twitter, etc. Additionally, the proper business rules are needed so that Sporting News Editors can quickly identify contextual related stories when creating a Trending Topic hub page and updates.

Super Stories are larger stories that encompass all related items. Super Stories look at all angles, viewpoints, and vantage points of the stories. These Super Stories should include the following:

- Text
- Story All Sporting News
- Images Sporting News & Web
- Video Sporting News & Web
- Web Curated Content
- Social Twitter/Facebook
- Milestones Points in which the story has changed
- Topics e.g. Brett Favre, Randy Moss

Standard stories can have some of the above elements, but not all.

On the web, viewers can look at Super Story elements through several views. These elements should be accessible to users via their mobile devices as well.

1. Summary View

Provides Sporting News' take along with the best photos, videos, articles and social commentary from Sporting News and the rest of the web. This page acts like a topic hub page.

2. Story View

Allows the user to read the most recent development related to the topic, while giving them insight into the past. Additionally, as the Hub Page, this acts as a landing page for the topic, which gives the user background to how the story has developed over time, including glimpses of other pieces.

3. Photo View

Sporting News has curated the best photos from Sporting News and throughout the web.

4. Video View

Sporting News has curated the best videos from Sporting News and throughout the web.

5. Web View

Sporting News Editors pick the best contest from around the web.

6. Social View

Social Media content will display Facebook, Twitter and other specific Social Media channels.

DEVELOPING STORIES

Developing Stories incorporate breaking news or breaking stories. "The quickest way for a user to find out what is new in sports today." These evolving stories quickly tell the user what is new in sports today. Developing stories could comprise the following:

- Important Injury News
- Trade
- League Violations

These are the initial gateway for every story until the background is filled out. Developing Stories can evolve into Super Stories or enhanced stories over time or remain as a standard story. Additionally, Developing Stories can feed into larger stories and Big Topics as a related story, become a milestone of a Big Topic, become a Big Topic themselves or be completely unrelated.

PERSONALIZATION

When personalized, the Sporting News will display what is new to the user from their last login date. This feature allows the user to mark stories and topics as the most interesting to them. It is important to take a user through the experience of becoming a specialized user. Building this a relationship with the user will extend and enhance their experience with Sporting News.

There are two methods to personalization:

- 1. Indirect
- 2. Direct

This relies on multiple factors:

- 1. Entry Point
- 2. Basic Browsing Metrics

Following their click through, like Amazon.com recently viewed/suggestions

- 3. Geo-location
- 4. Social Media Data
- 5.Confirmation

Calls to Action, Surveys, Quizzes/Polls (these all will validate their personal interests/experiences)

For example: based on a user's history or navigation through the site, an online persona can be developed from this collection of information. Once the relationship is established, then questions can be asked to confirm a user's preferences/personalization choices.

Additionally, Sporting News can incorporate indirect and direct information into a "My SN" or "My Feed" section, which will display Sporting News' interpretation of valued information from data/clicks and will also allow user to edit their profile directly. The user profile may show stories/topics related to their teams and interests based upon their selections, click throughs, geo-location and actions on the web and mobile sites.

Sporting News mobile readers will come with a varying array of mobile devices, as such, the mobile offering needs to feature streamlined content and adapt well to many screen sizes and hardware form factors. It is advisable to consider a dual approach – a HTML5 mobile website as well as specialized applications for devices like the iPad, iPhone, Android & RIM mobile devices.

DATA VISUALIZATION & ADVANCED ANALYSIS

Sporting News will provide the post-game analysis to tell the user the real story of what the statistics reveal. More than just Sabremetrics, advanced statistics tell a more compelling story over time, which better identifies important trends, and more accurately predicts player and team performance through analysis and data visualization. Using data visualization tools, Sporting News can help readers to quickly identify the most important facets of the game. Visualization can quickly tell the reader what is important and why.

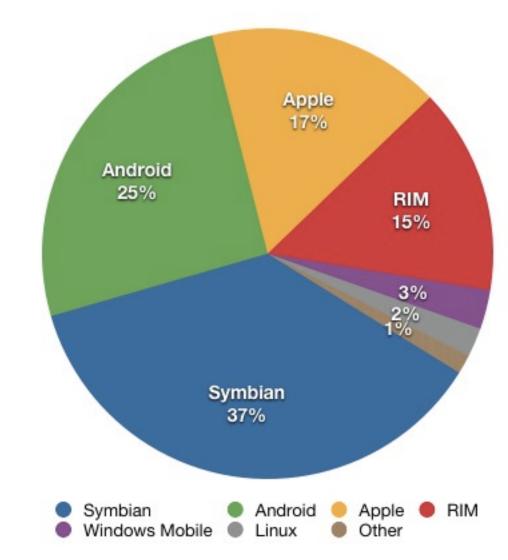
Sporting News' Advanced Analysis provides data visualization and in-depth statistical coverage beyond the traditional approach, as well as the themes and information that arise over a period of time about players, teams, match ups and overall trends. Providing a mobile user with advanced statistical analysis for the single game view in addition to a player(s), team(s) and the matchup(s) over a period of time will better enable the reader to understand the story. APPLE IOS





Background:

iOS devices (iPhones, iPads, iTouch & AppleTV 2) are rapidly gaining in popularity and as the standard to beat. One manufacturer for HW & SW equals a tighter and stronger User Experience.

Pluses:

- 1) Exclusive look and prominence on specific handsets
- 2) Great handset UX and established user base
- 3) Can build an offline version that functions even if the user is out of range
- 4) Allows third-party apps to do certain functions in the background
- 5) Create an easy way for all apps to save and enable fast app switching
- 6) Uses WebKit

Minuses:

- 1) Apple must approve every App release/update takes up to two weeks
- 2) Limited to iOS pool
- 3) Requires dedicated & seasoned development group

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

Good design reference. Apple leads the marketplace with strong Human Interface Guidelines.

Notes:

iOS is Apple's mobile operating system. Developed originally for the iPhone, it has since been shipped on the iPod Touch, iPad and Apple TV as well. Apple does not permit the OS to run on third-party hardware. As of October 20, 2010, Apple's App Store contains more than 300,000 iOS applications, which have collectively been downloaded more than 7.5 billion times, as per a keynote on October 20, 2010. As of May 2010, it had a 15.4% share of the smartphone operating system market in terms of units sold, third behind Symbian and RIM's Blackberry, but accounted for 59% of mobile web consumption (not including the iPad) in North America.

The user interface of iOS is based on the concept of direct manipulation, using multi-touch gestures. Interface control elements consist of sliders, switches, and buttons. The response to user input is immediate and provides a fluid interface. Interaction with the OS includes gestures such as swiping, tapping, pinching, and reverse pinching. Internal accelerometers are used by some applications to respond to shaking the device (one common result is the undo command) or rotating it in three dimensions (one common result is switching from portrait to landscape mode).

iOS is derived from Mac OS X, with which it shares the Darwin foundation, and is therefore a Unix-like operating system by nature. In iOS, there are four abstraction layers: the Core OS layer, the Core Services layer, the Media layer, and the Cocoa Touch layer. The operating system uses roughly 500 megabytes of the device's storage, varying for each model.

GOOGLE ANDROID





Background:

Android devices (e.g HTC Hero) are to iPhones as PCs were to Macintoshes in the 1980's & 1990's: more devices made by many different manufacturers offering flexibility & customization.

Pluses:

- 1) Significantly less stringent approval process
- 2) Available on a larger set of handsets not necessarily higher installed base
- 3) Public Perception of more handset choices equals more customizable experience
- 4) Android increasing in popularity, moving in on Apple's iOS
- 5) Uses WebKit

Minuses:

- 1) Rapid proliferation in handset models from various manufacturers with differing hardware capabilities
- 2) Since all handsets are very different difficult to develop applications that work on all Android-based phones
- 3) OS model is akin to Windows Single OS must be built for all possible devices & customized
- 4) Requires dedicated & seasoned development group
- 5) Android does not use established Java standards, i.e. Java SE and ME. This prevents compatibility among Java applications written for those platforms and those for the Android platform
- 6) Android only reuses the Java syntax, but does not provide the full-class libraries and APIs bundled with Java SE or ME.

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

Google has positioned Android as an open Operating System available on many hardware handsets and mobile operators.

Notes:

Android is a mobile operating system initially developed by Android Inc., a firm purchased by Google in 2005. Android is based upon a modified version of the Linux kernel. It is a participant in the Open Handset Alliance. Unit sales for Android OS smartphones ranked first among all smartphone OS handsets sold in the U.S. in the second and third quarters of 2010, with a third quarter market share of 43.6%.

Android has a large community of developers writing application programs ("apps") that extend the functionality of the devices. There are currently over 100,000 apps available for Android. Android Market is the online app store run by Google, though apps can be downloaded from third party sites (except on AT&T, which disallows this). Developers write in the Java language, controlling the device via Google-developed Java libraries. The Android operating system software stack consists of Java applications running on a Java based object oriented application framework on top of Java core libraries running on a Dalvik virtual machine featuring JIT compilation. Libraries written in C include the surface manager, OpenCore media framework, SQLite relational database management system, OpenGL ES 2.0 3D graphics API, WebKit layout engine, SGL graphics engine, SSL, and Bionic libc. The Android operating system consists of 12 million lines of code including 3 million lines of XML, 2.8 million lines of C, 2.1 million lines of Java, and 1.75 million lines of C++.

The unveiling of the Android distribution on 5 November 2007 was announced with the founding of the Open Handset Alliance, a consortium of 78 hardware, software, and telecom companies devoted to advancing open standards for mobile devices. Google released most of the Android code under the Apache License, a free software and open source license.

RIM BLACKBERRY





Background:

Blackberries are immensely popular in the business world. However, their market share is shrinking.

Pluses:

- 1) Large pool of devices worldwide
- 2) Less expensive devices
- 3) Open source
- 4) Contains social networking capabilities for developers
- 5) With WebWorks, developers can build Web applications for BlackBerry leveraging HTML5, CSS, and JavaScript
- 6) RIM is introducing BlackBerry Analytics SDK, providing developers with reporting & analytics on use of applications

Minuses:

- 1) OS requirements are a factor
- 2) Requires dedicated & seasoned development group
- 3) Opera web browsers are less standardized and buggy

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

RIM is facing stiff competition from Apple and Google and have lost significant market share within the business world.

Notes:

BlackBerry is a line of mobile e-mail and smartphone devices developed and designed by Canadian company Research In Motion (RIM) since 1996. BlackBerry commands a 14.8% share of worldwide smartphone sales, making it the fourth most popular platform after Nokia's Symbian OS, Google's Android, and Apple's iOS. The consumer BlackBerry Internet Service is available in 91 countries worldwide on over 500 mobile service operators using various mobile technologies.

BlackBerry functions as a personal digital assistant with address book, calendar and to-do list capabilities. It also functions as a portable media player with support for music and video playback and camera picture and video capabilities. BlackBerry is primarily known for its ability to send and receive (push) Internet e-mail wherever mobile network service coverage is present, or through Wi-Fi connectivity. BlackBerry is mainly a messaging phone with the largest array of messaging features in a smartphone today, including auto-text, auto-correct, text prediction, support for many languages, keyboard shortcuts, text emoticons, push email, push Facebook and Myspace notifications, push Ebay notifications, push instant messaging with BlackBerry Messenger, Google Messenger, ICQ, Windows Live Messenger and Yahoo Messenger; threaded text messaging and a customizable indicator light near the top right of all Blackberry devices. All notifications and conversations from applications are shown in a unified messaging application which third party applications can access also. Many of these applications would have to be running in the background of other phones to be used. BlackBerry's push gives BlackBerry devices their renowned battery life. All data on the phone is compressed through BlackBerry Internet Service (BIS).

Modern GSM-based BlackBerry handhelds incorporate an ARM 7, 9 or ARM 11 processor, while older BlackBerry 950 and 957 handhelds used mudit 80386 processors. The latest GSM BlackBerry models (8100, 8300 and 8700 series) have an Intel PXA930 624 MHz processor, 256 MB (or 4 GB in case of the torch 9800) flash memory and 265 MB SDRAM. CDMA BlackBerry smartphones are based on Qualcomm MSM6x00 chipsets which also include the ARM 9-based processor and GSM 900/1800 roaming (as the case with the 8830 and 9500) and include up to 256MB flash memory. The CDMA Bold 9650 is the first to have 512mb flash memory for applications. All modern BlackBerrys support up to 32gb microSD cards.

NOKIA SYMBIAN OS





Background:

Nokia Symbian devices have the largest percentage, approximately 40%, in global market share, but this is quickly shrinking as smartphones become cheaper.

Pluses:

- 1) Largest global market share
- 2) Founded by large manufacturers and providers within the mobile marketplace
- 3) Bought by Nokia in 2008
- 4) Uses WebKit

Minuses:

- 1) OS requirements are a factor
- 2) Requires dedicated & seasoned development group
- 3) Opera web browsers are less standardized and buggy

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

Nokia is losing market share fast. They still hold the lead in the global marketplace, but that number is surely to come down as smartphones like the iPhone and Android phones become more ubiquitous.

Notes:

The S60 Platform (formerly Series 60 User Interface) is a software platform for mobile phones that runs on Symbian OS. S60 is currently amongst the most-used smartphone platforms in the world. It was created by Nokia, who made the platform open source and contributed it to the Symbian Foundation. S60 has been used by mobile device manufacturers including Siemens mobile, Lenovo, LG Electronics, Panasonic and Samsung. Sony co-created the software with Nokia. Symbian was the most popular smartphone OS on the market by 47% of the sector's total sales, with 17.9m handsets sold in Q4 2008.

In addition to the manufacturers the community includes:

- Software integration companies such as Sasken, Elektrobit, Teleca, Digia, Mobica,
 Atelier.tm
- Semiconductor companies Texas Instruments, ST Microelectronics, Broadcom, SONY, Freescale, Samsung Electronics
- Operators such as Vodafone and Orange who develop and provide S60-based mobile applications and services
- Software developers and independent software vendors (ISVs).

S60 consists of a suite of libraries and standard applications, such as telephony, PIM tools, and Helix-based multimedia players. It is intended to power fully-featured modern phones with large color screens, which are commonly known as smartphones.

The S60 software is a multivendor standard for smartphones that supports application development in Java MIDP, C++, Python and Adobe Flash. Originally, the most distinguishing feature of S60 phones was that they allowed users to install new applications after purchase. Unlike a standard desktop platform, however, the built-in apps are rarely upgraded by the vendor beyond bug fixes. New features are only added to phones while they are being developed rather than after public release. Certain buttons are standardized, such as a menu key, a four way joystick or d-pad, left and right soft keys and a clear key.

HP PALM webOS





Background:

Nokia Symbian devices have the largest percentage in global market share, but this is quickly shrinking as smartphones become cheaper.

Minuses:

- 1) Very small user base
- 2) Requires dedicated & experienced programming team

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

HP's acquisition of Palm suggests that they are anxious to dethrone Apple and Google's attention of the market. webOS offers a great experience to users, but are they buying?

Notes:

HP Palm webOS is Palm's proprietary mobile operating system running on the Linux kernel. The Palm Pre smartphone was the first device to launch with webOS, and both were introduced to the public at the Consumer Electronics Show in Las Vegas on January 8, 2009. The Palm Pre and webOS were released on June 6, 2009. The second device to use the operating system, the Palm Pixi, was released on November 15, 2009. The webOS features significant online social network and Web 2.0 integration. HP webOS 2.0 was released in October 2010, with incremental changes such as better multi-tasking.

webOS's graphical user interface is designed for use on devices with touchscreens. It includes a suite of applications for personal information management and makes use of a number of web technologies such as HTML5, JavaScript, and CSS. Palm claims that the design around these existing technologies was intended to spare developers from learning a new programming language. The Palm Pre, released on June 6, 2009, is the first device to run this platform. Devices currently running updated versions of webOS 1.x.x include the Palm Pre and Palm Pixi on Sprint, and the "Plus" versions that run on Verizon Wireless and AT&T, as well as some international carriers. Although webOS version 2 has been announced, and its features outlined it is not yet available for these consumer devices. It appears that the first consumer devices with webOS 2 will be new Pre 2 phones in France from SFR possibly as early as 2010 October 22, and then elsewhere. Subsequent release of webOS 2 for the devices presently running the version 1 webOS appears to be slated to be "available in the coming months." All webOS devices appear to be able to migrate to the new version, although Pixi and Pixi Plus, because of slower processor speeds, will not run Adobe Flash Player 10.1 Beta, which will run on Pre, Pre Plus and Pre 2 only.

On April 28, 2010, HP announced that it had agreed to acquire Palm for \$1.2 billion.[4] The deal was completed on July 1, 2010.[5] The Palm global business unit will be responsible for webOS software development and webOS based hardware products, from a robust smartphone roadmap to future slate PCs and netbooks.

INTEL/NOKIA MEEGO





Background:

MeeGo is designed to act as an operating system for hardware platforms such as netbooks, entry-level desktops, nettops, tablet computers, mobile computing and communications devices, in-vehicle infotainment devices, SmartTV / ConnectedTV, IPTV-boxes, smart phones, and other embedded systems.

Pluses:

1) Available on many devices

Minuses:

- 1) Requires dedicated & experienced programming team
- 2) Small user base

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

MeeGo is an example of Linux being aimed at the non smartphone market.

Notes:

MeeGo is a Linux-based open source mobile operating system project which was announced at Mobile World Congress in February 2010 by Intel and Nokia in a joint press conference. Its aim is to merge the efforts of Intel on Moblin and of Nokia on Maemo into one project. It is hosted by the Linux Foundation. According to Intel, MeeGo was developed because Microsoft did not offer comprehensive Windows 7 support for the Atom processor. Novell also plays a large part in the MeeGo effort, working with the Linux Foundation on their build infrastructure and official MeeGo products, and MeeGo is increasingly using more of Novell's technology that was originally developed for openSUSE, (including openSUSE Build Service, ZYpp for package management, and other system management tools).

MeeGo is primarily designed to act as an operating system for hardware platforms such as netbooks, entry-level desktops, tablet computers, mobile computing and communications devices, in-vehicle infotainment devices, connected-TVs, IPTV-boxes, smart phones, and other embedded systems.

Harmattan, originally slated to become Maemo 6, is now considered to be a MeeGo instance (though not a MeeGo product), and Nokia is giving up the Maemo branding for Harmattan and beyond (Maemo 5, aka Fremantle, and previous versions will still be referred to as Maemo).

WINDOWS PHONE





Background:

Windows Phone 7 is the successor of Microsoft's Windows Mobile 6.5 mobile operating system. Microsoft's goal is to create a compelling and predictable user experience by redesigning the user interface, disallowing partners to modify or replace it, integrating the operating system with other services, and strictly controlling the hardware it runs on.

Pluses:

- 1) Microsoft wants to create a compelling and predictable user experience.
- 2) Disallows OS modification by partners
- 3) MS wants an Apple like experience on more phones

Minuses:

- 1) Lack of customization may not entice carriers and manufacturers to use OS
- 2) Small user base Relaunch was not successful

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

Good design reference. Named best interface MS has had in years. Focus on graphic interface – fluid motion and interaction. Good combination of contrasting ICON imagery in small tiles. Good combination of pictures, icons, text, and motion. Windows Mobile has lost significant market share and dominance since the release of the iPhone & Android smart phones and the increased prominence of RIM mobile handsets. Microsoft has an uphill battle ahead of them and are challenging established conventions in order to gain more market share and consumer's attention.

Notes:

Windows Phone 7 is a mobile operating system developed by Microsoft, and is the successor to their Windows Mobile platform. It launched in Europe, Singapore and Australia on October 21, 2010, and in the US & Canada on November 8, 2010, with Asia to follow in 2011. With Windows Phone 7, Microsoft offers a new Metro user interface, integrates the operating system with Microsoft's other services, and plans to strictly control which hardware it runs on.

Microsoft unveiled Windows Phone 7 on February 15, 2010, at Mobile World Congress 2010 in Barcelona and revealed additional details at MIX 2010 on March 15, 2010. Windows Phone 7 was released to manufacturing on September 1, 2010, and the final SDK was made available on September 16, 2010.





Background:

Before the introduction of WAP, service providers had extremely limited opportunities to offer interactive data services, but needed interactivity to support now-commonplace activities.

- 1) Limited Software capabilities
- 2) User Experience is very simplistic

Key Interaction/Takeaways:

WAP is still relevant for its attention to Lowest Common Denominator.

Notes:

Wireless Application Protocol (WAP) is an open international standard. A WAP browser is a commonly used web browser for small mobile devices such as cell phones. Before the introduction of WAP, service providers had extremely limited opportunities to offer interactive data services, but needed interactivity to support now-commonplace activities such as:

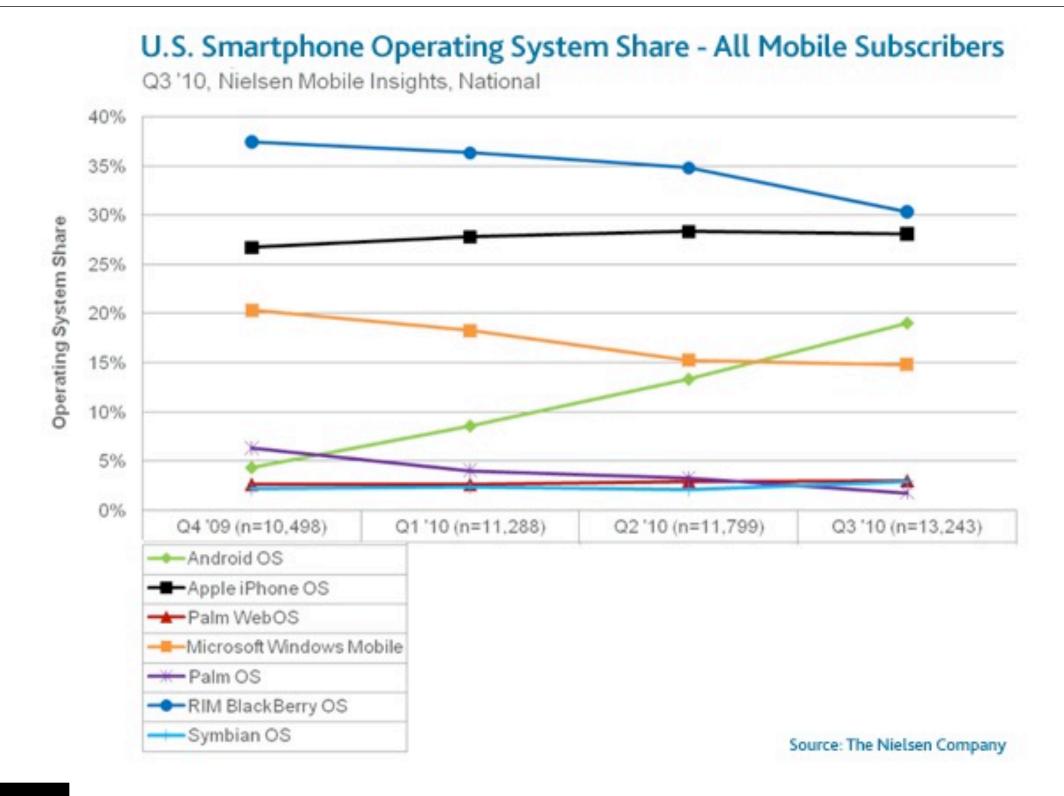
- Email by mobile phone
- Tracking of stock-market prices
- Sports results
- News headlines new
- Music downloads

WAP 2.0, released in 2002, a re-engineered WAP, uses a cut-down version of XHTML with end-to-end HTTP (i.e., dropping the gateway and custom protocol suite used to communicate with it). A WAP gateway can be used in conjunction with WAP 2.0; however, in this scenario, it is used as a standard proxy server. The WAP gateway's role would then shift from one of translation to adding additional information to each request. This would be configured by the operator and could include telephone numbers, location, billing information, and handset information. Mobile devices process XHTML Mobile Profile (XHTML MP), the markup language defined in WAP 2.0. It is a subset of XHTML and a superset of XHTML Basic. A version of cascading style sheets (CSS) called WAP CSS is supported by XHTML MP.

Spin-off technologies, such as MMS (Multimedia Messaging Service), a combination of WAP and SMS, have further driven the protocol. An enhanced appreciation of device diversity, supported by the concomitant changes to WAP content to become more device-specific rather aiming at a lowest common denominator, has allowed for more usable and compelling content. As a result, the adoption rate of WAP technology is on the upswing. The original WAP model provided a simple platform for access to web-like WML services and e-mail using mobile phones in Europe and the SE Asian regions. As of 2009 it continues with a considerable user base. The later versions of WAP, primarily targeting the United States market, were designed to enable full web XHTML access using mobile devices with a higher specification and cost, and with a higher degree of software complexity.

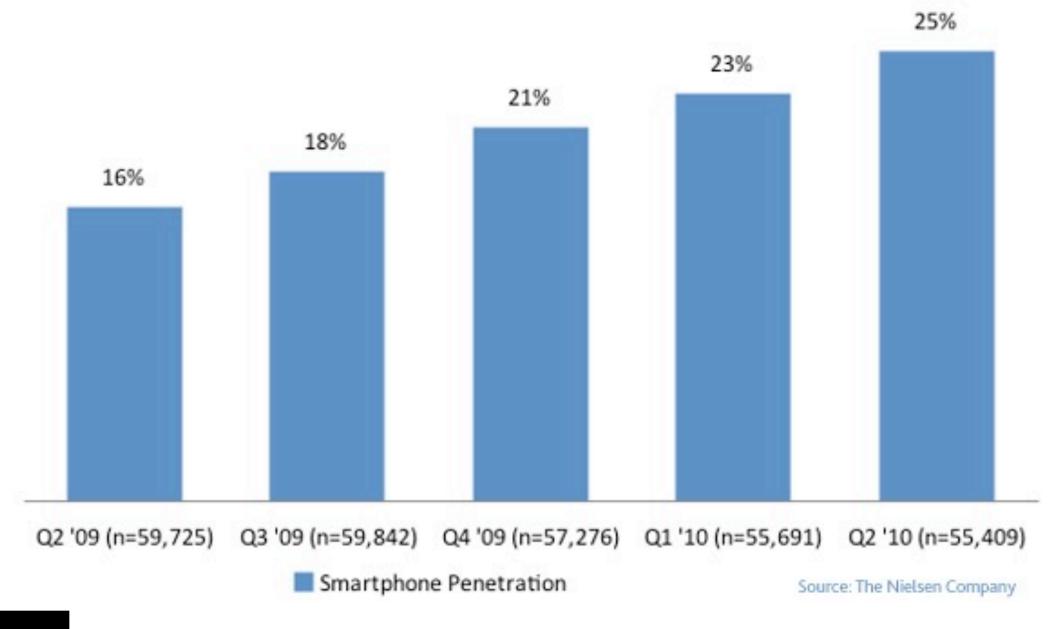

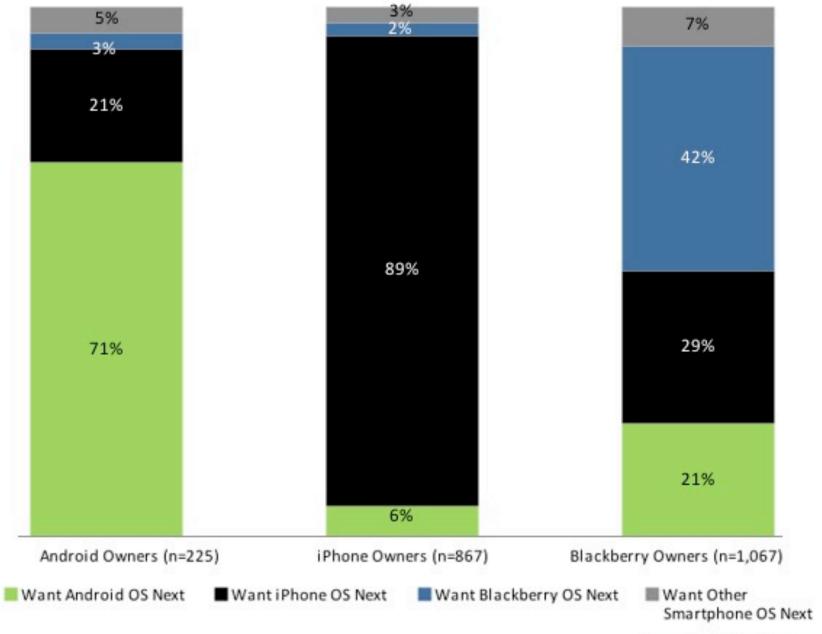

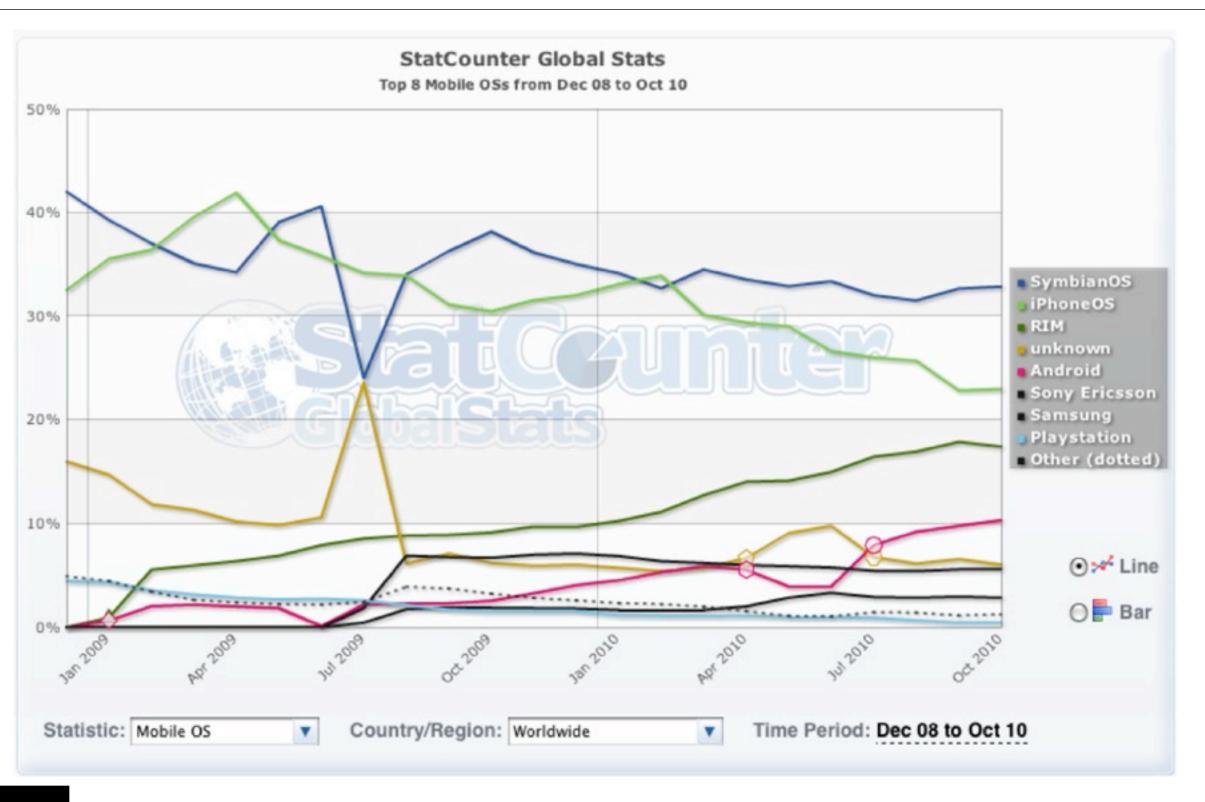

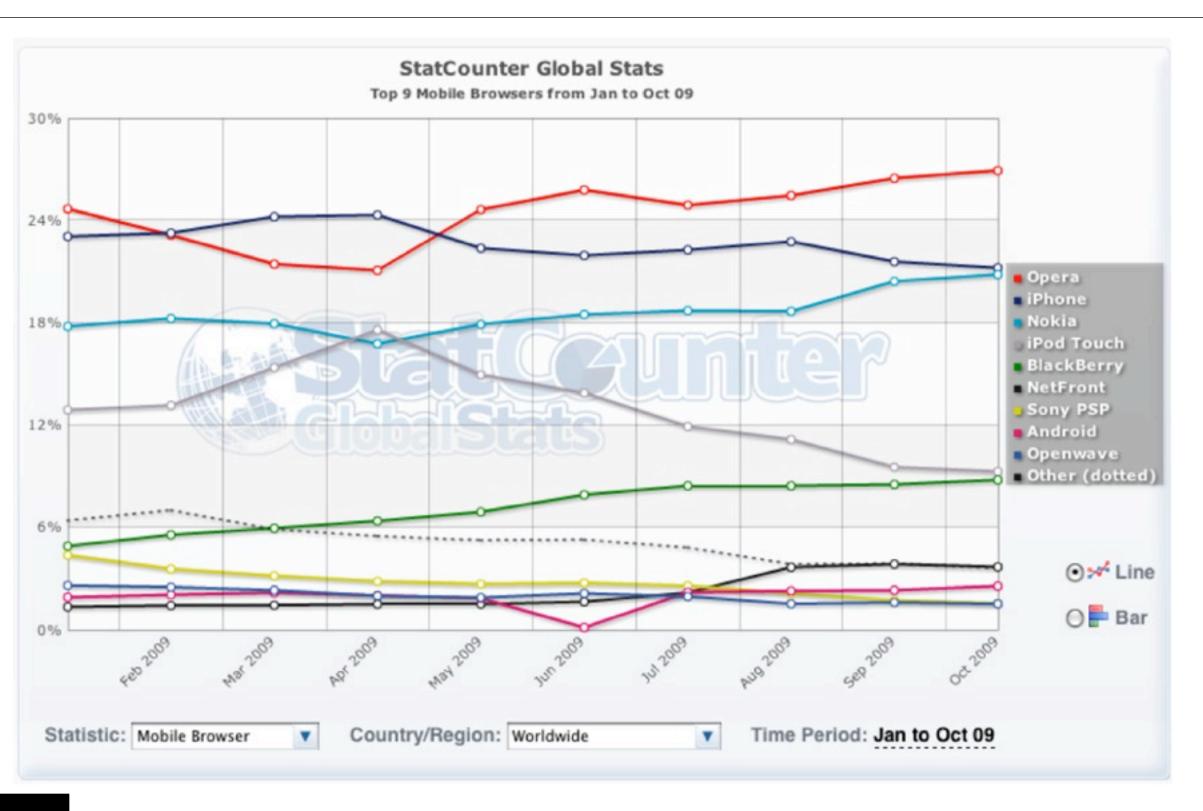
This graph illustrates the trend of top mobile OSs between December of 2008 through October 2010.

iOS is Apple's mobile operating system. Developed originally for the iPhone, it has since been shipped on the iPod Touch, iPad and Apple TV as well. Apple does not permit the OS to run on third-party hardware. As of October 20, 2010, Apple's App Store contains more than 300,000 iOS applications, which have collectively been downloaded more than 7.5 billion times, as per a keynote on October 20, 2010. As of May 2010, it had a 15.4% share of the smartphone operating system market in terms of units sold, third behind Symbian and RIM's Blackberry, but accounted for 59% of mobile web consumption (not including the iPad) in North America.

The user interface of iOS is based on the concept of direct manipulation, using multi-touch gestures. Interface control elements consist of sliders, switches, and buttons. The response to user input is immediate and provides a fluid interface. Interaction with the OS includes gestures such as swiping, tapping, pinching, and reverse pinching. Internal accelerometers are used by some applications to respond to shaking the device (one common result is the undo command) or rotating it in three dimensions (one common result is switching from portrait to landscape mode).

iOS is derived from Mac OS X, with which it shares the Darwin foundation, and is therefore a Unix-like operating system by nature. In iOS, there are four abstraction layers: the Core OS layer, the Core Services layer, the Media layer, and the Cocoa Touch layer. The operating system uses roughly 500 megabytes of the device's storage, varying for each model

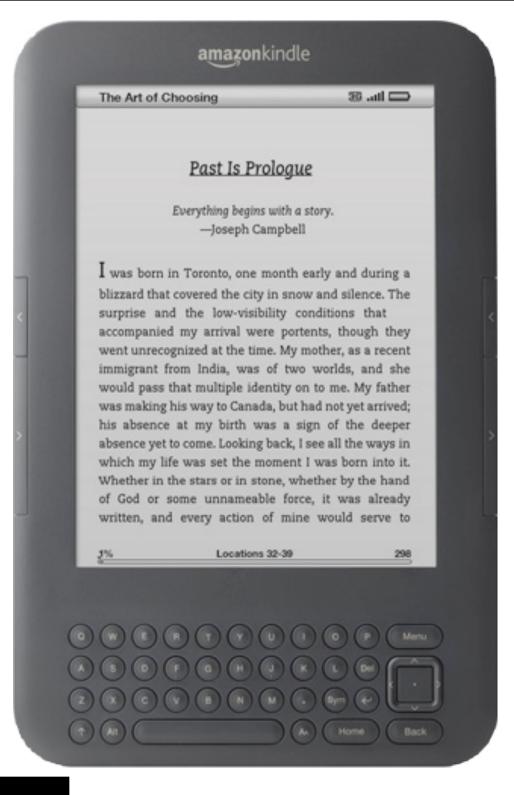

Android is a mobile operating system initially developed by Android Inc., a firm purchased by Google in 2005. Android is based upon a modified version of the Linux kernel. Google and other members of the Open Handset Alliance collaborated to develop and release Android to the world. The Android Open Source Project (AOSP) is tasked with the maintenance and further development of Android. Unit sales for Android OS smartphones ranked first among all smartphone OS handsets sold in the U.S. in the second and third quarters of 2010, with a third quarter market share of 43.6%.

Android has a large community of developers writing application programs ("apps") that extend the functionality of the devices. There are currently over 100,000 apps available for Android. Android Market is the online app store run by Google, though apps can be downloaded from third party sites (except on AT&T, which disallows this). Developers write in the Java language, controlling the device via Google-developed Java libraries. The unveiling of the Android distribution on 5 November 2007 was announced with the founding of the Open Handset Alliance, a consortium of 78 hardware, software, and telecom companies devoted to advancing open standards for mobile devices. Google released most of the Android code under the Apache License, a free software and open source license.

The Android operating system software stack consists of Java applications running on a Java based object oriented application framework on top of Java core libraries running on a Dalvik virtual machine featuring JIT compilation. Libraries written in C include the surface manager, OpenCore media framework, SQLite relational database management system, OpenGL ES 2.0 3D graphics API, WebKit layout engine, SGL graphics engine, SSL, and Bionic libc. The Android operating system consists of 12 million lines of code including 3 million lines of XML, 2.8 million lines of C, 2.1 million lines of Java, and 1.75 million lines of C++.

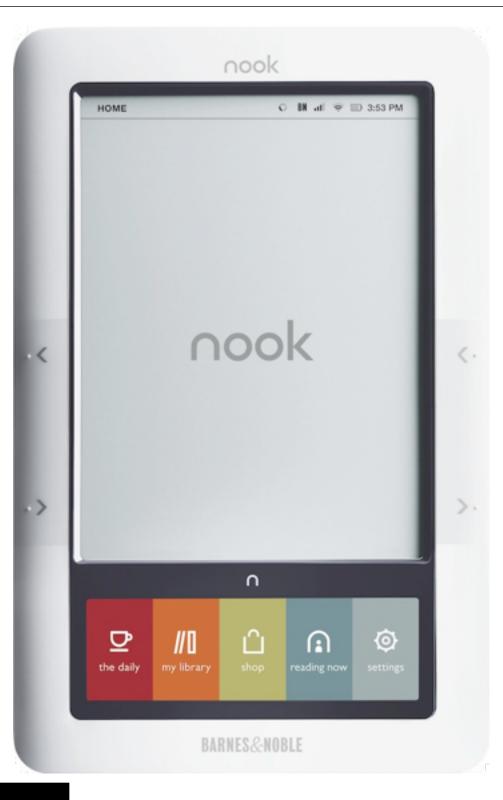

Several hardware devices support this platform, including a main "Kindle" line and a parallel "Kindle DX" line.

The most recent Kindle device is the third incarnation of the main line, officially named "Kindle", but usually referred to as "Kindle 3". Kindle 3 was released on August 27, 2010. User reports indicate that the new display on the Kindle 3 is noticeably superior to previous generations. The Kindle DX line features larger screens than the main Kindle line. It is marketed as more suitable for displaying newspaper and textbook content. Amazon has also introduced Kindle software for use on various devices and platforms, including Microsoft Windows, iOS, BlackBerry, Mac OS X (10.5 onwards) and Android. The Kindle hardware devices use an E Ink brand electronic paper display that features 16 shades of gray. This allows for a long battery life and easy readability. Content for the Kindle can be purchased online and downloaded wirelessly, using either standard Wi-Fi or Amazon's 3G "Whispernet" network. Whispernet is accessible without any monthly fee or wireless subscription, although fees can be incurred for the delivery of periodicals and other content when roaming internationally beyond the customer's home country. Through a service called "Whispersync", customers can synchronize reading progress, bookmarks and other information across Kindle hardware devices and other mobile devices.

The Kindle 3 Wi-Fi, is initially priced at US\$139 / GB£109, and connects to the Internet exclusively via public or private Wi-Fi networks. The Kindle 3 3G is priced at US\$189 / GB£149 and includes both 3G and Wi-Fi connectivity. The new Kindle with 3G is available in two colors: classic white and graphite. Both models use the new E ink "Pearl" display, which Amazon claims is 50% better in contrast - a claim that is backed up by early user reports. The third-generation Kindle is 0.5 inches shorter and 0.5 inches narrower than the Kindle 2. It supports additional fonts and international Unicode characters. Internal memory is expanded to 4 GB. The battery can allegedly last for up to one month of reading with the wireless radios turned off. On August 25, 2010, Amazon announced that the Kindle 3 was the fastest-selling Kindle ever.

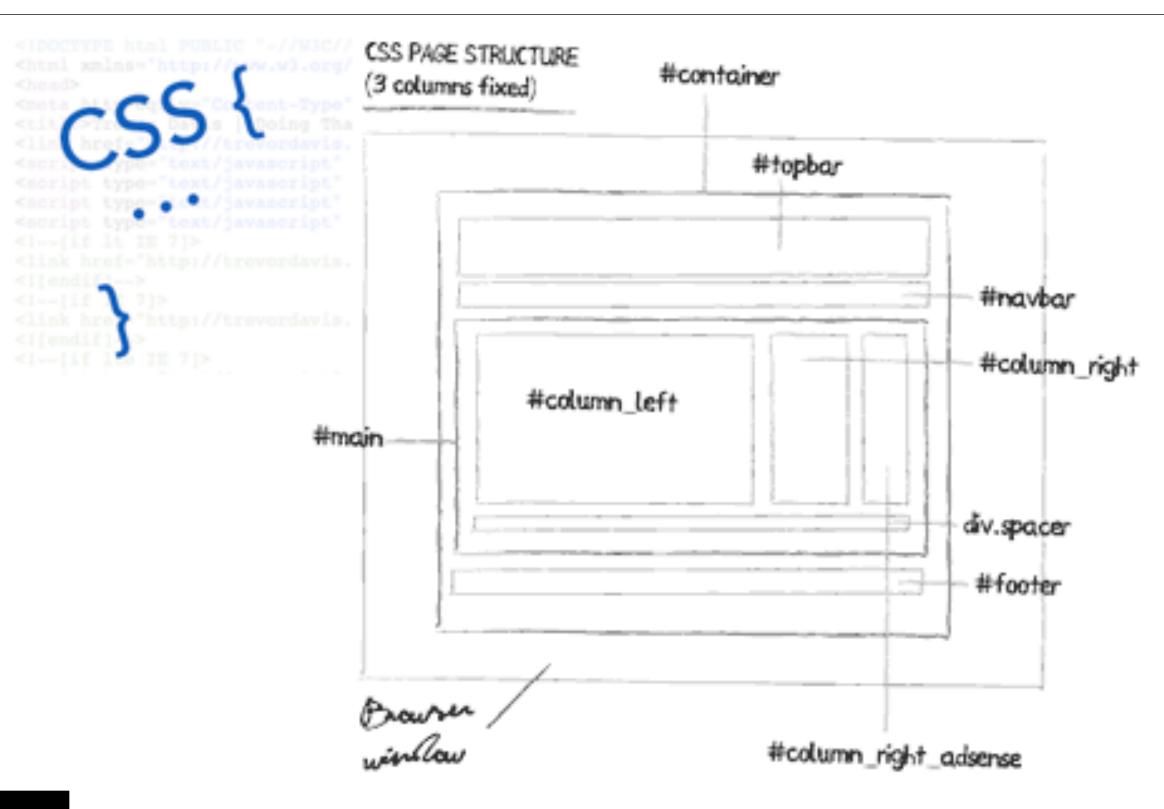

While the author of a document typically links that document to a CSS style sheet, readers can use a different style sheet, perhaps one on their own computer, to override the one the author has specified.

CSS specifies a priority scheme to determine which style rules apply if more than one rule matches against a particular element. In this so-called cascade, priorities or weights are calculated and assigned to rules, so that the results are predictable. The CSS specifications are maintained by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C). Internet media type (MIME type) text/css is registered for use with CSS by RFC 2318 (March 1998). The popularity of CSS as a design tool has increased exponentially and is now regarded as the premier system for website design.

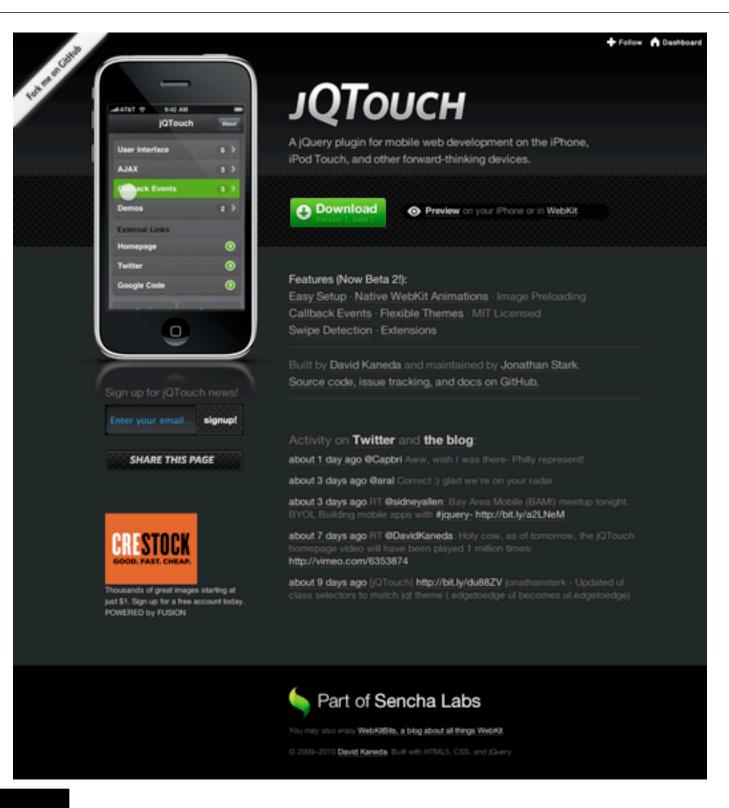

This contributes to the creation of powerful and dynamic web pages.

Microsoft and Nokia have announced plans to bundle jQuery on their platforms, Microsoft adopting it initially within Visual Studio for use within Microsoft's ASP.NET AJAX framework and ASP.NET MVC Framework while Nokia has integrated it into their Web Run-Time widget development platform. JQuery has also been used in MediaWiki since version 1.16.

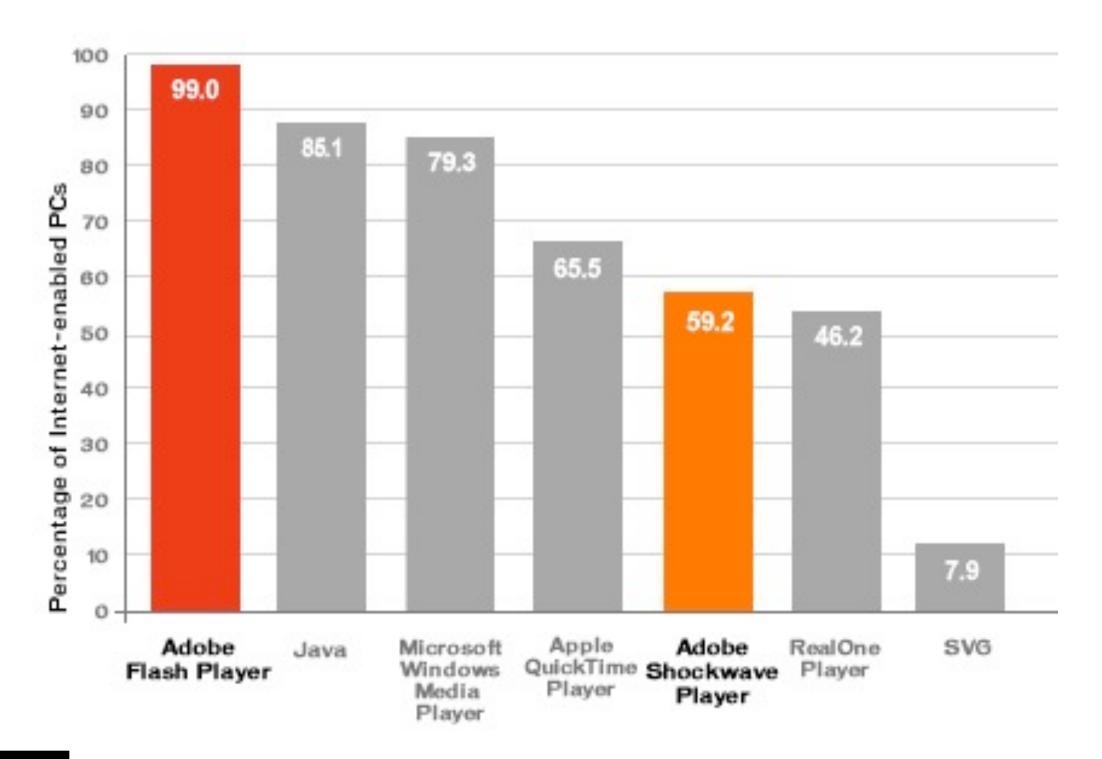

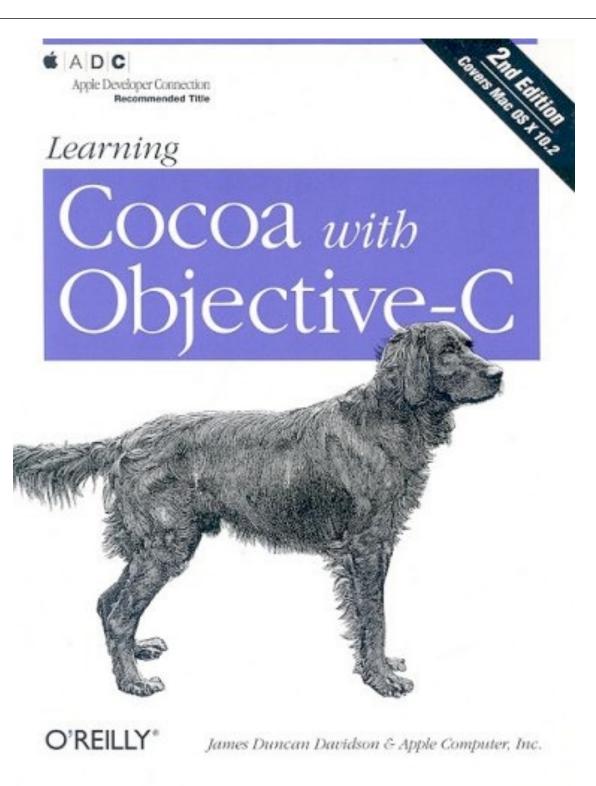

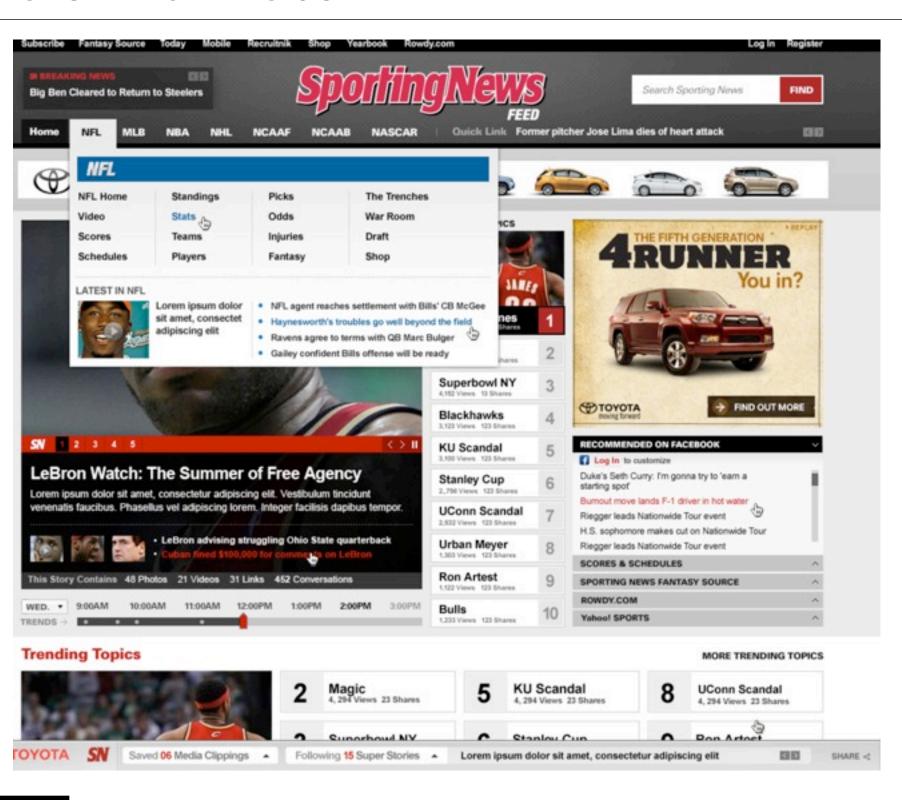

Objective-C, which adds Smalltalk-style messaging to the C programming language, is the primary language used for Apple's Cocoa API, and it was originally the main language on NeXT's NeXTSTEP OS. Generic Objective-C programs that do not utilize these libraries can also be compiled for any system supported by gcc or Clang.

Objective-C is a thin layer on top of C, and moreover is a strict superset of C; it is possible to compile any C program with an Objective-C compiler, and to freely include C code within an Objective-C class. Objective-C derives its object syntax from Smalltalk. All of the syntax for non-object-oriented operations (including primitive variables, preprocessing, expressions, function declarations, and function calls) are identical to that of C, while the syntax for object-oriented features is an implementation of Smalltalk-style messaging.

BBC Sport's website is also the UK's biggest and most popular sport website and is increasingly adding video and audio coverage to its scores and text news services. BBC Sport provides radio coverage for BBC Radio 1, BBC Radio 2, BBC Radio 4, BBC Radio Five Live and BBC World Service.

Due to the public status of the BBC, advertising is forbidden and as a result, sports matches covered by BBC Sport are not allowed to be sponsored, although the present commercialisation of sport makes this almost impossible in practice. In the face of increased competition from its rival broadcasters the BBC has softened its stance and is now contractually obliged to refer to certain competitions by their sponsored name under the terms of broadcasting rights deals.

BBC Sport launched a trial of the High Definition television format of the 2006 Football World Cup in HDTV as part of a wider trial of that format by the BBC. With the official launch of BBC HD, live football matches and golf have led the channel's sports output, and the BBC is rumoured to be studying the possibility of airing Premier League highlights in HD. Roger Mosey, Director of BBC Sport, announced in January 2009 that the BBC's aim "is for all our sport production to be in HD by 2012 at the latest". BBC Sport Interactive was launched in June 2008 on BBC Red Button, it is available on digital cable, satellite and terrestrial by pressing the red button and selecting page 300.

The 2.0 version of OpenID also supports an authentification form called an XRI, which marries an i-name (similar to the original OpenID url) to an i-number(unique identifier which never changes), thus allowing for a more secure form of identification. Perhaps Open ID's biggest win was Yahoo's decision to allow Yahoo users to convert their Yahoo id's into Open ID's in January 2008.

The OpenID Foundation is a non-profit organization that manages the efforts to increase adoption of the OpenID standard across the web. By using the service, internet users can authenticate at various websites with one digital identity managed through the OpenID standard. OpenID came from the unification of 4 different user-centric identity efforts that learned about each others' efforts at the [Internet Identity Workshop] in the fall of 2005: OpenID created by LiveJournal founder Brad Fitzpatrick, LID (Lightweight Identity) created by Johannes Ernst, founder of [NetMesh], XRI/i-names created by [Drummond Reed] and the XRI TC at [OASIS] and SXIP protocol created by Dick Hardt, CEO of Sxip.

In a display of its promise as a technology and its support by technology's biggest players, the OpenID Foundation has a Corporate Board comprised of Google, IBM, Yahoo, VeriSign, and Microsoft.

Background:

Unlike competitor Pandora, Last.fm's recommendations are not generated by matching similar musical attributes. However, its community driven engine gives it more potential to grow into media other than music. This is most likely a reason why media giant, CBS, acquired Last.fm for \$280 million in May of 2007. Last.fm grew from very modest funding compared to its competitors Pandora, ilike, MyStrands and others.

Users "scrobble" the music they listen to on their ipod or computer through a downloaded application that records what they listen to. The scrobbler then sends this data to Last.fm's servers. The engine produces a station by grabbing music from other users' whose taste is similar to your own. Additionally, users can have a radio station made around a single artist. These stations are created by recommending music that other users listen to in addition to your chosen artist. Additionally, Last.fm has largely incorporated social networking into its site. It has user profiles, events and widgets for your website. This is quite appropriate considering recommendations and stations are generated using communal data.

Last.fm has extended its service to multiple online platforms with the "Last.fm in a box" application. This allows partners to offer their users free access to Last.fm's streaming radio services direct from the partners Web site. Current partners include Bebo, Billboard.com, CBS Television Stations, CBS Affiliates, eMusic, Frengo, Gigya, iGoogle, and many others.

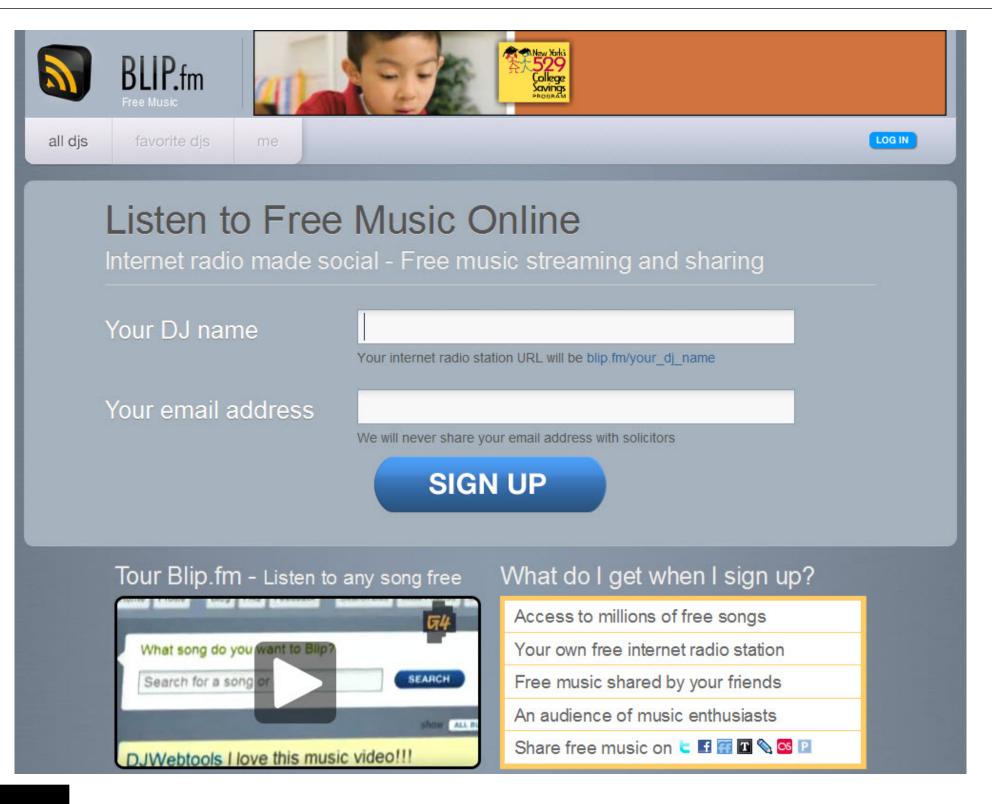
